Part 1

Man: I can see her. She's got curly hair.
Girl: That's right.

Can you see the line? This is an example. Now you listen and draw lines.

Man: Who's that sitting on the box?
Girl: The girl drawing a tiger?
Man: Yes, that girl.
Girl: That's Kim. She's good at drawing.
Man: Yes. Her picture is beautiful.

Man: It's hot today.
Girl: Yes, it is. Look at Fred!
Man: What's he doing?
Girl: He's the one carrying an ice cream.
Man: Is he wearing a blue T-shirt and black trousers?
Girl: That's right.

Girl: Can you see May?
Man: What's she wearing?
Girl: She's wearing a red T-shirt.
Man: Is she looking at a map of the zoo?
Girl: Yes, she is!
Man: That's clever.

Girl: Oh, look at Nick!
Man: Which one's he?
Girl: He's wearing a brown T-shirt.
Man: Yes, I can see him.

Girl: Can you see the monkey on his shoulder?
Man: Oh yes! That's exciting.

Man: And who's the boy with the blonde hair?
Girl: The one with a camera?
Man: Yes. He's taking a photo of the monkey.
Girl: That's Sam. He doesn't like drawing.
Man: I would like to see the photo.
Girl: Me too!

Woman: Ok, thank you.

Woman: What did you do?

Woman: Did you go to the doctor?
Nick: No. But I was in bed all day. I read my book from the library.

3. What did the family buy at the shops?

Paul: Yes, she got herself a new watch.

4. What was the matter with Paul on Sunday morning?

Paul: No, I had a stomach ache. I didn't have a temperature, just a stomach ache. And I was OK by lunchtime.
Woman: Good.

5. Which person is Paul's cousin?

Woman: What did you do Sunday afternoon?
Paul: I went to the cinema with my cousin.
Woman: Is that the boy with curly black hair?
Paul: No, that's my brother. My cousin has got straight black hair.
Woman: Does he wear glasses?
Paul: Yes, he does.
Woman: I know who he is.
